- **V.** PRAYER IS **E**MPHATIC (1:9; 4:2)
  - **A.** We never Cease praying (1:9).
  - **B.** We Desperately seek Him (4:2).

"O God, You are my God; Early will I seek You; My soul thirsts for You; my flesh longs for You..." Psalm 63:1

C. We Watch for His guidance (4:2). *"I will instruct you and teach you in the way you should go; I will guide you with My eye."* Psalm 32:8

# VI. PRAYER IS **R**EWARDING (1:12; 4:3)

**A.** We get an Inheritance (1:12).

"In Him also we have obtained an inheritance, being predestined according to the purpose of Him who works all things according to the counsel of His will," Ephesians 1:11

**B.** We get to See Christ (4:3).

"3 When I consider Your heavens, the work of Your fingers, The moon and the stars, which You have ordained,

4 What is man that You are mindful of him, And the son of man that You visit him?

5 For You have made him a little lower than the angels, And You have crowned him with glory and honor." Psalm 8:3-5

**C.** We must be Fruitful (1:10).

# III. PRAYER IS $\mathbf{A}$ VAILABLE (1:9)
