Speaking Gifts

- I. <u>Prophecy:</u> A Speaking gift with special ability to apply Scripture to the hearer's life producing conviction
- II. <u>Evangelism:</u> A Speaking gift with special ability to communicate the gospel to unbelievers in such a way as to produce conversion
- III. <u>Teaching:</u> A Speaking gift with special ability to explain the truth in such a way as to produce understanding and strengthened faith
 - a. "word of knowledge"—teaching to instruct the mind and deepen understanding
 - b. "word of wisdom"—teaching to apply the truth to life
- IV. <u>Exhortation:</u> A Speaking gift with special ability to speak the truth in a way that produces comfort and encouragement
- V. <u>Discernment:</u> A Special ability to hear others speak the word and to discern whether or not the instruction is sound and faithful to Scripture

Serving Gifts

- I. <u>Service/Helps:</u> A special ability to see the physical need(s) of others and the compulsion to move personally and quickly to meet those needs.
- II. <u>Leadership/Administration</u>: A special ability to see a situation, recognize what needs to be done, and a willingness to lead and encourage others to bring resolution.
- III. <u>Giving</u>: A special ability to see the material needs of others and an extra-ordinary readiness to give toward meeting those needs.
- IV. <u>Mercy</u>: A special ability to see the emotional needs of others and the compulsion to move with compassion and urgency to meet those needs.
- V. <u>Faith</u>: A special ability to see a problem and to recognize what truths from Scripture apply to it, along with an extraordinary confidence in God's ability to do what He has said, enabling this person to strengthen the faith of others
- VI. <u>Healing and Miracles:</u> Manifest in a special ability to pray for others in need. This is a special ability to see the profound needs of others (physical and spiritual) and the confidence to pray boldly for God's grace and power to be revealed in their lives



Additional Speaking Gifts?

- 1. <u>Shepherding:</u>["] The burden and ability to see other's spiritual needs and to meet them with the word of God
