The Authority of Christ Matthew 7:28-29 May 29, 2011

*Introduction / Review:* Consider the content of the sermon Jesus preached in *Matthew 5:2—7:27*; it was followed by a certain reaction, "astonishment at His doctrine and authority..."

# I. <u>At His Doctrine...</u>

It was:

- 1. Essentially central to His public ministry... Mark 6:34
- 2. Clearly of Divine origin... John 14:24 cf. 6:40
- 3. It was the truth... Psalm 40:8-10
- 4. It was deep and covered all subjects... Psalm 119:96
- 5. It came with understanding, conviction and sincerity... Isaiah 61:1ff
- 6. It was effective... John 10:14ff

## **Observation:**

- 7. It was a mercy to hear Him... John 17:8, 14, 17
- 8. It far exceeded in grace and excellence anything they had ever heard... John 1:14ff cf. John 6:63; 5:24; 6:68
- 9. It was focused upon salvation and holiness of life... Matthew 5:20

## II. <u>At His Authority (power by right)</u>

- 1. He preached with the conviction that what He said was absolute truth... John 3:9-15
- 2. He had a mandate from God... John 4:34; 5:30, 36
- 3. He had the Holy Spirit without measure... John 3:34
- 4. He only taught what the Scriptures taught... Matthew 5:17 cf. John 10:35
- 5. He possessed a clear vision as to the value of man's never dying soul... Matthew 16:26
- 6. He knew the danger of living and dying in unbelief... John 3:18-19
- 7. He spoke out of the authority of an impeccable, sinless life... Matthew 11:29 cf. John 13:15 with 8:46
