Jonah: The Reluctant Prophet Jonah 1:1-16

- I. <u>RESPONSIBILITY</u>: "go to Ninevah" (vv.1-2) A. Authority: "The word of the LORD came to Jonah"
 - B. Assignment: "cry against it, for their wickedness"

II. <u>RESISTANCE</u>: "Jonah rose to flee" (v.3)

- A. Wrong Direction: "So he went down to Joppa"
- **B. Wrong Motivation:** "from the presence of the LORD"

III. <u>REACTION</u>: "the great storm (vv.4-16)

- A. Danger: "the ship was about to break up" (vv.4-6)
 - 1. Restless Fear: "the sailors became afraid"
 - 2. Restful Faith: "Jonah...sound asleep"

B. Discovery: "the lot fell on Jonah" (vv.7-10)

- 1. Investigation: "on whose account this calamity"
- 2. Indictment: "How could you do this?"

C. Dilemma: "What should we do?" (vv.11-15) 1. Solution: "throw me into the sea"

2. Satisfaction: "the sea stopped its raging"

D. Decision: "feared the LORD" (v.16)

- 1. Internal: "the men feared the LORD greatly"
- 2. External: "they offered a sacrifice...vows"
