
Trust in God's presence and protection 1:5

Trust in God's presence and protection 1:5

- _ God promises to be with each obedient follower. "I will not leave you or forsake you."
- No evil plan of Satan can prevail against us if we do exactly what God tells us to do. "No man shall be able to stand before you all the days of your life."
- _ Do not compare your experiences of and with God to the experiences of others. "Just as I was with Moses, so I will be with you."
