The Reasons for Evangelistic Praying (vv.3-7)

- It is Reflective of God's *Nature* (v.5a)
 - One of the most fundamental teachings of Scripture is that there is *one* God
 - Another fundamental teaching of Scripture is that there is *one* salvation



The Reasons for Evangelistic Praying (vv.3-7)

- It is Consistent with Christ's *Person* (v.5b)
 - The Bible states emphatically that there is only *one* mediator
 - Jesus Christ became *man*



The Reasons for Evangelistic Praying (vv.3-7)

- It is Consistent with the Atonement's *Purpose* (v.6)
 - Christ *gave*
 - Christ gave His life for *all*
 - Christ gave Himself to be testified in *due* time



The Reasons for Evangelistic Praying (vv.3-7)

- It is Consistent with Paul's *Commission* (v.7)
 - He was appointed a *preacher*
 - His *defense* of his commission
 - His *delineation* of his commission



The Attitude of Evangelistic Praying (v.8)

- It is Given as a *Command* (v.8a)
- It is Directed at *Men* (v.8b)
- It is Specified as *Holiness* (v.8c)
