<sup>8</sup> Remember the sabbath day, to keep it holy. <sup>9</sup> Six days shalt thou labour, and do all thy work: <sup>10</sup> But the seventh day *is* the sabbath of the LORD thy God: *in it* thou shalt not do any work, thou, nor thy son, nor thy daughter, thy manservant, nor thy maidservant, nor thy cattle, nor thy stranger that *is* within thy gates: <sup>11</sup> For *in* six days the LORD made heaven and earth, the sea, and all that in them *is*, and rested the seventh day: wherefore the LORD blessed the sabbath day, and hallowed it.

<sup>12</sup> Honour thy father and thy mother: that thy days may be long upon the land which the LORD thy God giveth thee.

<sup>13</sup> Thou shalt not kill.

<sup>14</sup> Thou shalt not commit adultery.

<sup>15</sup> Thou shalt not steal.

<sup>16</sup> Thou shalt not bear false witness against thy neighbour.

<sup>17</sup> Thou shalt not covet thy neighbour's house, thou shalt not covet thy neighbour's wife, nor his manservant, nor his maidservant, nor his ox, nor his ass, nor any thing that *is* thy neighbour's.

## QUESTION # 144: WHAT ARE THE DUTIES REQUIRED IN THE NINTH COMMANDMENT?

**ANSWER:** THE DUTIES REQUIRED IN THE NINTH COMMANDMENT ARE, THE PRESERVING AND PROMOTING OF TRUTH BETWEEN MAN AND MAN,<sup>A</sup> AND THE GOOD NAME OF OUR NEIGHBOUR, AS WELL AS OUR OWN;<sup>B</sup> APPEARING AND STANDING FOR THE TRUTH;<sup>C</sup> AND FROM THE HEART,<sup>D</sup> SINCERELY,<sup>E</sup> FREELY,<sup>F</sup> CLEARLY,<sup>G</sup> AND FULLY,<sup>H</sup> SPEAKING THE TRUTH, AND ONLY THE TRUTH, IN MATTERS OF JUDGMENT AND JUSTICE,<sup>I</sup> AND IN ALL OTHER THINGS WHATSOEVER;<sup>J</sup> A CHARITABLE ESTEEM OF OUR NEIGHBOURS;<sup>K</sup> LOVING, DESIRING, AND REJOICING IN THEIR GOOD NAME;<sup>L</sup> SORROWING FOR,<sup>M</sup> AND COVERING OF THEIR INFIRMITIES;<sup>N</sup> FREELY ACKNOWLEDGING OF THEIR GIFTS AND GRACES,<sup>O</sup> DEFENDING THEIR INNOCENCY;<sup>P</sup> A READY RECEIVING OF A GOOD REPORT,<sup>Q</sup> AND UNWILLINGNESS TO ADMIT OF AN EVIL REPORT,<sup>R</sup> CONCERNING THEM; DISCOURAGING TALE-BEARERS,<sup>S</sup> FLATTERERS,<sup>T</sup> AND SLANDERERS;<sup>U</sup> LOVE AND CARE OF OUR OWN GOOD NAME, AND DEFENDING IT WHEN NEED REQUIRETH;<sup>V</sup> KEEPING OF LAWFUL PROMISES;<sup>W</sup> STUDYING AND PRACTISING OF WHATSOEVER THINGS ARE TRUE, HONEST, LOVELY, AND OF GOOD REPORT.<sup>X</sup>
