



Revelation 13:11-18

There are seven important personages of the Seventieth Week of Daniel which are described in Revelation 12-13.

1. The Woman Clothed with the Sun – Israel (Rev. 12:1-2)
2. The Great Red Dragon – Satan (Rev. 12:3-4)
3. The Child – Jesus (Revelation 12:5)
4. Michael (Rev. 12:7)
5. The Remnant – Israel not in the “safe spot” (Rev. 12:17)
6. The Beast out of the Sea – The Antichrist (Rev. 13:1-10)
7. The Beast out of the Earth – The False Prophet (Rev. 13:11-14)

These are described in the pause between Rev. 11:19 and Rev. 15:5.

Revelation 13:11-12

One more member of the unholy trinity is described in these verses. First came the Great Red Dragon, which counterfeits God the Father. Next came the Beast out of the Sea, which counterfeits God the Son. Now comes the Beast out of the Earth, which counterfeits God the Holy Spirit. Match these descriptions with the appropriate member of the unholy trinity.

Revelation 13:13-15

The Beast out of the Earth (a.k.a. – the False Prophet – Rev. 19:20) uses miracles to validate his message and deceive the world into worshipping the Antichrist. An image of the Antichrist is erected, and all are required to worship it (sound familiar?).

Revelation 13:16-17

Extreme economic pressure is applied to any who hesitate to pledge their loyalty to the Beast out of the Sea. Maybe the mark is one level, the name of the Beast is another level, and the number of the Beast is yet another level of access to the world economy.

Revelation 13:18

Although it might mean more, the revealing of the number of the Beast (Antichrist) may be only to remind confused and wavering believers in these horrible days to come that, after all, the Beast is only a man.
