The Hope of Wholeness

Pastor Phil Winfield Mark 5:21-34 May 3, 2015

Note the tale of two sick women.

- 1. Sickness is **devastating** (v.25-28)
 - a. Sickness can be **inexplicable** (v.25).
 - b. Sickness can make you **desperate** (v.26).
 - c. Sickness can take over **your finances** (v.26).
 - d. Sickness tends to **isolate you** (27-28).
- 2. **Jesus cares** about our devastating sickness (29-34).
 - a. Jesus responds to the **feeble cry** of faith (v.29-30).
 - b. Jesus knows who **reaches out** in faith (v.31).
 - c. Jesus sought her to make a **<u>public confession</u>** (v.32-33).
 - i. Jesus is always looking for a public confession of a **private deliverance**.
 - ii. Jesus healed her for His glory and for her <u>reconnection</u> to society.
 - d. Jesus sought her to give her not only healing but **wholeness**! (v.34).
 - i. You are part of my family. **Daughter!**
 - ii. Your Faith has **saved** you.
 - iii. Be at **peace**.

Today, we pray for **healing**; Jesus offers **wholeness**.
