ANOTHER TALMUDIC MYTH

- Verse One makes clear that the Hebrews arrived at Mr. Horeb at least 60-90 days after leaving Egypt (Passaver) (Hebrews used a 30-day junar calendar)
- During the Second Temple period, after the Babylanian Captivity, the Jews associated Pentecost (50 days) with the giving of the Law at Mt. Hoteb
 - During the Babylonian Captiful the Jews had no temple, thus they had no Festivals i.e., they were in danger of losing their culture.
 - Changing the focus of the holy day kept their culture without the femple.
 - they were not receiving the New Covenant waship of Low, not God of Law
 - This charged the hoty day from offering God the "first fruits" of the harvest, two loaves of leavened bread (God giving His Holy Spirit to Chitchars who were the first fruits of the New Coverant rejected by Jewill.

ONE FINAL MYTH TO DISPEL

- Verse 4 (Eagle's wings) The word eagle is not in the Hebrew, just wings
 - This could mean any bird's wings but usually the Griffon Vulture is intended.
 Phibronys were not defailed biologists! however, Western minds prefer earlies.
 - The word wings could also refer to the talkit garment (prayer covering His people) as it does in several verses; but, its depart had not yet been given (law).
- The context expresses God's care for the Hebrews in many respects
 - He not only tooked to their physical needs
 - He sought to make them aware of their spiritual heeds preparing them to receive His Low in humbly
 - Hebrews reception of the Law elevated their pride then and ever tince

THE FIRST AGREEMENT

GOD CALLS MOSES

- God calls Mases to Mount Hoteb to set the terms for the Hebrews based on Himself Isimilar to how He approached Abraham High 1914.
- However, this coveriant was different from the coveriant mode previously in the Scriptures – it was a "conditional" coveriant
 - Unconditional covenant Its terms were set by God Who would fulfit its terms
 - Conditional developing its forms were set by God but mon had to fulfill its forms

- Moses takes God's messages to the Elden.
 - Edars take a memage to the people, probably via the chain of juager
 - The people receive a message from God
 - Everyone, but Mores, propably heard this message (not from God).

- Mates takes the people's answer back to God we will do this
- In effect, this constitutes an agreement to hear God I Words
 - There will be a covenantal meat of agreement after the giving of the Law
 - Yet they will turn away from obliving God's words very quickly
- God gives instructions on how the people are to prepare themselves to receive His words.
 - Make yourselves "clean" (holy) for two days prepare to see true holines;
 - Wash their gaments
 - Wall for God's signal on the third day
 - . Do NOT fouch the maunitain of God when He is on the mountain man or beaut

 - Ancient practices included abstinence, thus, if was a "given" to avoid sex
- The addition to God's words is what initiated sin in the Garden when Adam overemphasized God's admonition by adding "do not touch" to the " do not eat" of the tree of knowledge suggests to the

ritual cleanness emphasized

- God is laying the foundation for ritual cleanness to convey the understanding of sointual cleanness
 - The Old Testament was mixed in the autward ritual purilication process with little understanding of the spiritual cleanness required to satisfy the Law which was impossible for all men thecause of inherent sin patient.
 - The New Testament, after the resurrection of Christ, smashed the locade of ritual cleanness, emphasizing spiritual cleanness based on the imputed righteourness of Christ along to the believer apart from works of the field.
- God's haliness not previously emphasized in Scripture, thus, this is the first time man confronted with the understanding of haliness.
 - Matter bright was not to fouch the mountain in God's presence
 - Violating God's holitess was punishable by death

GOD'S HOLINESS DISPLAYED

- Third day downs with "long" frumpet blast
 - God's holy presence in the form at cloud and the (piles of cloud and fire)

- This audio-visual display designed to convey the separation between a holy.

 - This display was designed to impress upon the people that violation of God's Law meant facing God's wrath, the result of inherent sin nature
 - Violation of God's holiness anly meets with God's wrath and judgment
 - All who reject God's salvation must meet God's wraft #n F22 to 5 + 7 R+ 20.1 (8)
 - An act of grace conveying the truth. "fear of God is the beginning of wedom" (knowing God's holiness can lead to rependance) in 197-16 1111 to 1117 to 127.

HOLINESS PRODUCES REPENTANCE, NOT GROVELING

- This display not designed to produce groveling obelsance which is worthless.
 - God sees thought and infants of the heart groveling is of Satan (iii + 4.1).
 - Regentance leads to sulvation, a new nature loving hoteiss accessions.
- . The flesh users to please that with a stward forms of piets to semain in un-
 - . This became entrined in the Tolmud (Mishna & Gernara) Babe Jews)
 - Puer seek to imposed these outward forms on all people via the Noahide town
 - Chast condemned empty: dufward forms of piety 88 12.513, 22.33-30
- Understandable they did not immediately perceive the intent of the Law but after about 400 years some people did perceive the inult of the Law
 - God's Law undergraded by holiness produced rependance (demonstrated God's level in "true Jews" until Christ's stauros: Prist 1447 No.2 IP-27 833-39.

MOSES BRINGS THE ELDERS TO MOUNT HOREB

- Nearly every source, both Christian and Jewish, agree that Moses did not bring the entire Hebrew population to the base of Mount Horeb
 - They could see the events from the camp in the plain before Mount Horeb
 - Elders, as the people's representatives could relay all they had seen and health
 - Same tources do say that at males 20 y/o and above came to the mount
- Everyone admonshed to NOT touch the mountain or they would be idled
 - Stones
 - Allow
- In fact, God fels Moses to go back down and warn the people again, shawing His merciful grace (no pleasure in death of sinners) (ETHER THE STATE)

PRIESTHOOD, WHAT PRIESTHOOD?

- God sends Moses back down the mount to warn the people again not to come up the mount to see God or they will die.
 - Moses fiells God this warring has already been conveyed (God knew that)
 - God perceived cutosity would cause the bolder ones to approach answar
 - . God was again demonstrating His menty and grace
- God then makes an interesting statement about priests
 - The Attranc preshood has not been established
 - Moses is not questioning the statement so some priesthood must have existed
- We are left with a allemma
 - · Ether one believes God's word has a contradiction
 - There is a priesthood in place we have overlooked

PATRIARCHS OR PREVIOUS PRIESTHOODS

- Patriarchal Priesthood General time period of Abraham
 - Job demanstrates the preshood or patriorch (head) of his ciar
 - He performed the Ascending Societies daily for his older and himself piles 1-2-4-2-2-3
 - Abraham performed sacrifices for his family
 - He was tasked with sportfung leage to demonstrate his furth in God and God's availse of an her apart from his own works (Ge 22)-16, He 11, 17-19.
- Other Priesthood Post Catactysm
 - Melchizednik was a prest who was also outside of Abraham's line (6=14.17.2)
 - While many believe this was a theophary. I believe he was a human priest from Stem's consider? testimony of God which kept the both extant.
 - He was a "type" of a beller than Agronic priesthood in 1104 He 534 x 14778.

PRIESTHOOD OF FIRSTBORN

- Jewish scholars recognize this priesthood as the first born males who were consecrated to the Lord
 - God referred to trace as His firstborn emphasizing the importance of firstborns
 - God sacrificed firstborn of those who did not opply blood to their lintels #442138
 - God instructed the Hebrews that all frattom sors will be consecrated to Him
 and such appointed (westock would be either socrafted or redeemed its 13.0).
- This may have some ment as Christ was God's firstborn who was to the sacrifice for sin and then to be the high priest to the Father
 - Obviously, not supported by Jewish thought in any form as they consider Jesus to be in Hell continuously bolled forever in excessment flatmuct.
 - Not directly addressed in Scripture and Christ is a priest like Melichize delic

EMPHASIZING GOD'S HOLINESS

- God reiterated to Moses that there were NO exceptions to those who
 violated His holiness
 - The patriarchal prests were no more holy than the ruling elden
 - Pure may have been some who thought they were as "hot?" as Majes to Jok to God, a problem that will reappear in the Persistench, even among his kin
 - God felt Moses to tell these priests that they needed consecration also
- Then God makes an exception to His own rule Moses is to bring Agron
 - God allowed him to touch and experience His holiness in some measure
 - God elevated Agran above the patriarchal priest
 - Possible preparation for Agranic priesthood to administer the sacrificial Law
- Moses and Aaron return to God's presence, all receive the Ten Words
