- II. Everyone must please his or her neighbor (v. 2).
 - A. The example of Christ informs us (v. 3).
 - B. The Scriptures instruct us (v. 4).

Paul prays for harmony among believers that leads to God-glorifying worship (vs. 5-6).

- III. Everyone must welcome one another for the glory of God (v. 7a).
 - A. Because Christ welcomed us, both Jew & Gentile, for the glory of God (v. 7b-9).
 - B. Because the Scriptures predict it (vs. 9b-12).

Paul prays for lives abounding in hope (v. 13)
