ELISHA'S LAST MIRACLE (Postmortem) 2 Kings 13:14-25

I. <u>THE KING HONORS ELISHA</u> (14)

- A. Grieves at His Death Bed recognizes the national value of God's prophet
 - 1. Pays an Official Visit
 - 2. Weeps over Him
- B. <u>My Father, My Father</u>—relational; inferior to superior
 - 1. <u>Title of General Respect</u> (5:13)—shows deference either to age or to rank
 - 2. <u>Position of Spiritual Importance</u> (2:12)—a teacher or mentor
 - a. Authority—to instruct, command, rule; as professor, spiritual leader
 - b. Affection
 - 3. <u>Ideal of Mature, Manly Virtue</u>—a leader who takes responsibility for the safety, provision, nurture, discipline and direction of others
 - a. Fatherhood is something to be *desired*.
 - b. Fatherhood is a position of great responsibility.
 - c. Fatherhood is a position of <u>authority</u> that is <u>worthy of respect</u>.
 - 4. Fatherhood does not have to be biological.
- **C.** <u>The Chariots and Horsemen of Israel</u> —the mighty defender of Israel; Israel's spiritual strength, connection to divine aid of the Heavenly Host
 - 1. <u>Elijah's Honor Escort</u> (2:11)
 - 2. Elisha's Heavenly Protectors (6:16-17)
 - 3. Israel's Supernatural Defenders (7:6; 1 Chron 14:15)

II. <u>THE PROPHECIES ABOUT SYRIA</u> (15-19)

- A. <u>Shooting the Bow</u> (15-17; Ps 18:34; 144:1)—the prophet's guidance and promise:
 - A <u>Commission</u> to Attack the Syrians, even though the physical army of Israel is inferior.
 - 2. A <u>Promise</u> of Success, because the LORD will give him the victory.
- B. <u>Striking the Arrows</u> (18-19)—number of subsequent victories, evidence of character
 - 1. <u>To see how the king will make use of the blessing</u>
 - 2. <u>He will not completely destroy the Syrian threat</u>.

III. <u>THE MIRACLE OF ELISHA'S BONES (20-21)</u>

- A. <u>Honored by God</u> ()—this was a mighty, holy man!
- **B.** Evidence of the Afterlife life with God continues after death of the righteous.
- C. Authentication of His Ministry from God; what he said was true
- D. Foreshadowing of Christ's Ministry
 - 1. The Holiness and Power of Jesus
 - 2. The Authentication and Efficacy of His Ministry
 - 3. Our source of Comfort and Confidence
