 - Genuine righteousness ACCEPTS the standard set forth by God, (vs. 27); "He who commits

 ADULTERY lacks sense; he who does it DESTROYS himself. He will GET wounds and dishonor, and his disgrace will not be WIPED away. For jealousy makes a man furious, and he will not SPARE when he takes revenge. HE WILL ACCEPT no compensation; HE WILL REFUSE though you MULTIPLY gifts." (Proverbs 6:32–35, ESV)

Genuine righteousness UNDERSTANDS that intent is the real issue, (vs. 28); "My son, KEEP your father's commandment, and forsake not your mother's teaching. BIND them on your heart always; TIE them around your neck. When you walk, they will LEAD you; when you lie down, they will WATCH over you; and when you AWAKE, they will TALK with you. For the commandment is a lamp and the teaching a light, and the reproofs of discipline are the way of life, to preserve you from the evil woman, from the smooth tongue of the adulteress. Do not desire her beauty in your heart, and do not let her capture you with her eyelashes; for the PRICE OF A PROSTITUTE is only a loaf of bread, but a married woman HUNTS down a precious life." (Proverbs 6:20–26, ESV)

Genuine righteousness MOVES to deal with the problem materially, (vs. 29 – 30); "Blessed is the man who remains steadfast under trial, for when he HAS stood the test he will receive the crown of life, which God has promised to those who LOVE him. Let no one SAY when he is TEMPTED, "I am being tempted by God," for God cannot be tempted with evil, and he himself tempts no one. But each person is tempted when he is LURED and ENTICED by his own desire. Then desire when it has CONCEIVED gives birth to sin, and sin when it is fully GROWN brings forth death. DO NOT BE DECEIVED, my beloved brothers. Every good gift and every perfect gift is from above, COMING down from the Father of lights with whom there is no variation or shadow due to change. Of his own WILL he brought us forth by the word of truth, that we should be a kind of firstfruits of his creatures." (James 1:12–18, ESV)
