What we want to do is to stay balanced James 1:5 (ESV) If any of you lacks wisdom, let him ask God, who gives generously to all without reproach, and it will be given him.

If we do this, if we pray without ceasing

We will not become cowards, who are not willing to speak and not willing to confront the lost We want to be on guard against a spirit of laziness and cowardice On the other side we don't want to create needless offense We don't want to needlessly stir up opposition **Ephesians 5:15 (ESV) Look carefully then how you walk, not as unwise but as wise.** Surely we are for the most part sluggards when it comes to praying Especially when it comes to praying for knowledge, judgment, and a sound mind Let us pattern our lives after Him, let us be people of prayer and walk in His steps

Summary

The truth of this text should be pondered by all who try to do good in the world

For the man with no interest in living for the Lord, working to advance His Kingdom through His church these verses will have little interest

To the ministers, to those who seek to win souls and to those who labor in the local church these verses ought to interest them
