

Sharing the Lord's Supper
1 Corinthians 11:17–22

The Lord's Supper should be shared in the local church amongst brothers and sisters.

v. 17–18 - Paul addressed the problem of division in the church.

- The gathering of the church is a specific and unique meeting of Christians - **Acts 11:26 So it was that for a whole year they assembled with the church and taught a great many people. And the disciples were first called Christians in Antioch.**
- The church at Corinth was split up into different groups or cliques - **1 Corinthians 1:10–13; Romans 16:17 Now I urge you, brethren, note those who cause divisions and offenses, contrary to the doctrine which you learned, and avoid them.**

v. 19 - The divisions at Corinth were not theological but relational.

- Factions in a church can become heretical theologically - **2 Peter 2:1 But there were also false prophets among the people, even as there will be false teachers among you, who will secretly bring in destructive heresies, even denying the Lord who bought them, and bring on themselves swift destruction;**
- Factions in a church can become heretical relationally.
- Heresies test the genuineness of believers.
- Those who respond in Christ-likeness are those proven to be right

v. 20 - It is possible to eat the bread and drink the cup but not be observing the Lord's Supper.

- There is a meal that Christians observe that belongs to the Lord (Rev 1:10).
- The Lord's Supper is a specific and unique meal that is (should be) observed in the church gathering (alone) - **1 Corinthians 10:16–17**
- Doctrinal error and relational sins can negate the Lord's Supper.

v. 21–22 - The church at Corinth were split into factions over the haves and the have-nots.

- The early church probably shared a full meal together that included the Lord's supper shared during the meal - **Acts 2:40–47; Jude 1:12**
- The Corinthians were splitting up into cliques. Those who had an abundance to eat at the supper were not sharing with those who lacked.
- Disunity among Christian brethren is a heresy that should not be allowed at the Lord's supper.

The Lord's Supper is only to be eaten in a worthy manner - **1 Corinthians 11:27–34**

- You must understand the meaning of the Lord's Supper.
- You must believe the Lord Jesus Christ.
- You must be in right fellowship with Christ and His people.

Our prayer is that Village Bible Church will not be split into cliques but will always have a unity around doctrine and our relationship with Christ and each other.
