BIBLE DISCUSSION GROUP STUDY QUESTIONS

In preparation for Sunday, May 5, 2024

Memory Passage: 1 Corinthians 1:26-31

DAY 1 – ASK FOR INSIGHT

READ THE PASSAGE

Passage: 2 Cor 12:1-10

- (a) **Read 2 Corinthians 12:1-10.** Skim through 1 & 2 Corinthians. What types of problems were occurring in this church?
- (b) What sorts of false teachings and accusations are being brought into the church? (See 2 Cor.10:1-2,10; 11:1-6, 12-15, 21; 12:11)
- (c) Read Chapters 10-12. What is the flow of Paul's defense in chapters 10-12?

DAY 2 – ASK FOR INSIGHT

READ THE PASSAGE

- (a) **Read 2 Corinthians 12:1-10.** How is vs. 1 connected to the previous text (2 Cor. 11:30-33)?
- (b) What repeated words do you notice in this text?
- (c) Find the main units of thought in 2 Cor. 12:1-10. How are these units of thought connected? (Hint: in order to find the units of thought, be on the lookout for progressions of thought, changes in subject, repetition, etc.)

DAY 3 – ASK FOR INSIGHT

READ THE PASSAGE

- (a) **Read 2 Corinthians 12:1-10.** What is motivating Paul to speak about his visions and revelations in vs. 1-6, especially considering that vs. 1 says, "there is nothing to be gained by it"?
- (b) Describe the vision Paul experienced in vs. 1-6. What is Paul referring to by "third heaven" (vs. 2) and "paradise" (vs. 3)?
- (c) What does Paul mean in vs. 5 when he says that he will boast on behalf of this man, but not on his own behalf—except for his weaknesses? How does this compare with how the "superapostles" boasted?

DAY 4 – ASK FOR INSIGHT

READ THE PASSAGE

- (a) **Read 2 Corinthians 12:1-10.** According to vs. 7-10, what was the intent of Paul's thorn in the flesh?
- (b) What does it mean for Christ's grace to be sufficient? What does it mean for His power to be made perfect in weakness (vs. 9)?
- (c) What does Paul mean in vs. 10 when he says, "For when I am weak, then I am strong?" What are some examples in Paul's life where you see this truth demonstrated?

DAY 5 – ASK FOR INSIGHT

READ THE PASSAGE

- (a) **Read 2 Corinthians 12:1-10.** Describe how the power of God was perfected through Christ's weakness. (2 Cor. 13:3-4).
- (b) What thorns has God given you and how have you experienced Christ's power while enduring these afflictions? How can you begin boasting in your weaknesses?
