## III. Compare what happened to Barabbas and Jesus

- A. Barabbas hopelessly condemned Jesus had been approved by God (Mk 1:11; 9:7)
- B. Jesus or Barabbas?
  The world will always choose Barabbas!
- C. Substitution: Jesus takes Barabbas' place! Jesus bound – Barabbas freed

Jesus cursed – Barabbas blessed

Jesus killed - Barabbas lives

The "son of a father" released because THE Son of THE Father condemned!

## IV. Compare the **implications** for Barabbas and **you**

- A. You need Someone to take your place of judgment or you are hopeless
- B. There was nothing personal or permanent in Barabbas' deliverance
  - Not permanent
     Temporary delay of death
     His biggest problem still unsolved
  - 2. Not personal

Purely circumstantial that Barabbas was released But Jesus had you in mind from eternity, to die for you (Eph 1:4-8) Only those who have a personal **relationship** with Jesus are delivered by Him Do you?
