Matthew 27:66

c530-535B.C. Daniel in the lions' den.

Daniel 6:17 the stone sealed: absolute authority of Darius God delivered Daniel in spite of the seal!

Fast forward to Jesus.

Major theme of Matthew has to do with the unique **authority** of Jesus:

Matthew 7:29 8:9 9:6, 8 10:1 12:8 20:25ff 21:23-27

Then notice the detail, uniquely in Matthew: 27:66

The **seal** indicates the Sanhedrin and Rome's authority.

Jesus is not permitted out of the grave!
