

Error: Sinners tend toward one of two opposite errors a) we are worthless or b) we are gods.

**Truth: since we bear the name of The LORD - who is majestic in all the earth- we share His majesty, but not His divinity.**

**1. Our majesty comes from God's majesty.**

- b. Our majesty will never exceed God's majesty. (v.1,9)
- c. Our majesty will never be less than His creation. (v.3,5)
