TEXT: Ephesians 2:4 TITLE: "God is Merciful!" (Series: Attributes of God)

The Greek word eleos $(\tilde{\epsilon}\lambda\epsilon\sigma\varsigma)$ = "mercy; kindness or good will toward the miserable and afflicted, joined with a desire to relieve them" (THAYER).

"God's mercy is his tenderhearted, loving compassion for his people. It is his tenderness of heart toward the needy. If grace contemplates man as sinful, guilty, and condemned, mercy sees hm as miserable and needy" (Millard J. Erickson, *Christian Theology*, p. 295).

"It may be defined as *the goodness or love of God shown to those who are in misery or distress, irrespective of their deserts.* In His mercy God reveals Himself as a compassionate God, who pities those who are in misery and is ever ready to relieve their distress" (Louis Berkhof, *Systematic Theology*, v. 2, p. 72).

"MERCY (the quality of showing compassion) One aspect of this mercy is God's withholding the penalty that people deserve for their sins (Eph. 2:4; I Tim. 1:12-13). He could show this mercy toward us who are saved because of Christ's atoning work on our behalf" (Floyd H. Barackman, *Practical Christian Theology*, p. 38).
