### **What Sins Would Keep Someone from Going to Heaven?**

Any sin can.

### **Is Any Sin Greater than Another, (as in Sexual Sins)?**

Yes, some are.

### **Can a Believer Lose Their Salvation?**

No, you can't undo something God has done.

### **Can a True Believer Live in Sin to the very End of Their Life, and Still go to Heaven?**

No, God stops true believers from a life of sin.

### **Did You Use the terms for Pastors and Elders Synonymously Last Sunday Night?**

Yes, God does that twice.

## **1. What Sins Would Keep Someone from Going to Heaven?**

Any sin that any person dies with that sin still clinging to their account, keeps them from going to Heaven.

They would need forever to pay for one sin. (James 2:10 the same is guilty all).

Jesus only died for sin once (Heb. 10:10-14), and He saves us and justifies us either from ALL sins, or NO sins. No partial salvations are possible.

## **2. Is Any Sin Greater than Another, (as in Sexual Sins)?**

- Yes. All sin is lawlessness (1 John 3:4);
- There are sins that lead to death and sins that don't lead to death (1 John 5:16-17);
- But sins against Spirit are unpardonable (Luke 12:10; Mat. 12:31-32);
- Also sins against body are serious 1 Cor. 6:18.

## **3. Can a Believer Lose Their Salvation?**

No, John 10:28-29; Jude 24-25.

### **4a. Can a True Believer Live in Sin to the very End of Their Life, and still go to Heaven?**

First, who does God say won't go to Heaven? Rev. 21:8; Eph.5:1-7; Gal. 5:16-26; 1 Cor. 6:9-10; Rom. 1:28-32.

Second, in the church, what was the context of 2 Cor. 13:5's examine yourself whether you are saved? The sins of 2 Cor. 12:20-21.

### **4b. Can a True Believer Live in Sin to the very End of Their Life, and still go to Heaven?**

Third, always remember that if they are a believer, God will chasten them or else, if they remain un-chastened, they prove that they are illegitimate and never born-again children of God (Hebrews 12:3-24).

Fourth, believers who are chastened, and yet remain in unrepentant of their sins are weakened, sickened, and ultimately chastened to death in I Cor. 11:29-31; 1 John 5:16-17; Rev 2:21-23.

#### **4c. Can a True Believer Live in Sin to the very End of Their Life, and still go to Heaven?**

Finally, who is a true believer? Jesus said salvation is neither a prayer (Lord, Lord) nor a decision (did many things), it's a changed life of repentance (doeth) in Mat 7:21-23.

#### **5. Did You Use the terms for Pastors and Elders Synonymously Last Sunday Night?**

Yes, because God does so, in His Word when explaining the church, in 1 Peter 5:1-2, Acts 20:17, 28.
