**Deut. 32:8–9;
Dan. 10:13–21;
1 Kings 22**

Psa. 82:1, “A Psalm of Asaph.

Psa. 82:1, “God [*ʾElōhîm*] stands in the congregation of the mighty [*לְאֱלֹהִים*]; He judges among the gods [*ʾelōhîm*].”

Deut. 32:7, “Remember the days of old, consider the years of many generations. Ask your father, and he will show you; Your elders, and they will tell you:


Jude 10, “But these speak evil of whatever they do not know; and whatever they know naturally, like brute beasts, in these things they corrupt themselves.”

Jude 11, “Woe to them! For they have gone in the way of Cain, have run greedily in the error of Balaam for profit, and perished in the rebellion of Korah.”


