I. He comes as a Teacher II. He comes as Comforter

III. He comes as Homemaker

I. The Coming of Holy Spirit as our Teacher

- A. Jesus' announcement of the coming of the Holy Spirit (John 14:15-17)
 - 1. He is another Comforter Who in some ways is better
 - 2. How is Jesus' departure and Holy Spirit's arrival progress?
 - a. He will come as a Teacher: John 14:13-15; 16:13-16
 - b. But He is not like any other Gospel teacher (1 Cor. 2:11-14)
 - 3. The Holy Spirit will teach more about Jesus than Jesus Himself did
 - a. The Spirit will guide into all truth: He will receive of Jesus and shall it unto you: 14:21, 23; 16:13-16 (John 1:1-18)

II. The coming of Holy Spirit as the Comforter

- A. Jesus promises to send the Holy Spirit as a Comforter
 - 1. That was sweet word in the context of sadness (14:1; 16:6)
 - 2. Therefore He comforts them that He will leave them alone: 14:18!
- B. The Comforter Jesus promised is the absolute best
 - 1. Comforter means Advocate Legal assistant Helper (John 16:8-12)
 - 2. Why is He the best Advocate?
 - a. Because He is the best and most informed Witness of Jesus
 - b. Because He has the best insights in the believers He defends
 - c. Because He has the nearest access to the heart of God

- C. What solid comforts do all believers have!
 - 1. They have the best Advocate in heaven (1 John 2:1)
 - 2. They have the best Advocate in their hearts (Rom. 8:14-16; 26-27

III. The Coming of the Holy Spirit as the Home-Maker

- A. Jesus taught that not only the Holy Spirit would dwell and abide in us
 - 1. In John 14:17, 21, 23 reveals that all three will spiritually $% \left(1\right) =\left(1\right) \left(1\right) \left($
 - 2. As Jesus is the 'home-maker' in heaven for His people (14:1-3), so the Spirit is the 'home-make' in the heart (Eph. 2:21-22)
 - 3. What a Gospel comfort is the truth that *He* will prepare the heart!
- B. His work as the Home-Maker the calls sanctification
 - 1. Sanctification is renovation reconstruction making new creature
 - 2. What is the purpose for all this?
 - a. to make the believer a temple of God: 2 Cor. 3:18; 2 Cor. 6:14-18
 - b. to make all believers together the temple of God: Eph. 2:21-22
