HCQ71. Where does Christ promise that we are washed with his blood and Spirit as surely as we are washed with the water of baptism?

A. In the institution of baptism, where he says: "Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit."
"The one who believes and is baptized will be saved; but the one who does not believe will be condemned."
This promise is repeated when Scripture calls baptism "the water of rebirth" and the washing away of sins.

HCQ72. Does this outward washing with water itself wash away sins?

A. No, only Jesus Christ's blood and the Holy Spirit cleanse us from all sins.
