v1 *Conclusion* drawn from 7:24-<u>25</u>. Two-fold: **(1)** Positional; **(2)** Practical. Further reasons considered in finding comfort in our Lord.

1A NOT CONDEMNED AS REGENERATE BELIEVERS, vv1-4

- **1B** Free from the dominating control of our sinful nature, v2
- **2B** Our sinful nature too dominant for our will in itself, v3a
- **3B** Our sinful nature condemned & punished in Christ's death, v3b
- 4B Christ's perfect righteousness imputed to us by faith in Him, v4

2A NOT CARNALLY-MINDED AS REGENERATE BELIEVERS, vv5-8

- **1B** Obvious difference between living in the flesh & living in the Spirit, v5
- **2B** Only two possible outcomes then, v6
- **3B** Reason for death, v7
- **4B** Paul's conclusion about those "in the flesh" v8

3A NOT "IN THE FLESH" AS REGENERATE BELIEVERS, vv9-11

- 1B The marked difference between those "in the flesh" & those "in the Spirit", v9
- **2B** "Body" dead to God, but the "new you" alive because of Christ, v10
- **3B** God gives us power to live as Christ lived by His indwelling Spirit, v11
