**Title**: Life According to the Spirit | **Text**: Romans 8:12-17

Our former relationship with "sin in the flesh" (v3) was self-centered & fleetingly gratifying, appealing to our fleshly senses. Now, our relationship with Christ Jesus is God-centered & endlessly gratifying, appealing to our spiritual senses.

## LIFE ACCORDING TO THE SPIRIT OF GOD

Four essential life-characteristics of those who live according to the Spirit

**1A** Believers mortify well - by the Spirit, **v13**; **2A** Believers obey well - by the Spirit, **v14**; **3A** Believers speak well - by the Spirit, **v15**; **4A** Believers listen well - by the Spirit, **v16**, (which brings them comfort & assurance). ... The Spirit indwells us to work in us according to God's will.

I only want to deal with the first main point this morning—focusing only on v13.

## 1A BELIEVERS MORTIFY WELL - BY THE SPIRIT, v13

- **1B** What "putting to death" generally means
- **2B** There's a difference between what's *been* put to death & what *remains* to put to death.
- **3B** Our Lord Jesus teaches us that the source of sin arises from within our own hearts. (*Paul develops this teaching further in his epistles*)
- **4B** The Lord also teaches us to cut off/out body members that offend. (*Paul also develops this teaching of the Lord in his epistles*)

**APPL**: Things to consider in "putting to death" the deeds of the flesh by the Spirit

- 1) We put to death sinful deeds in the heart before they are acted out.
- 2) We don't ignore or entertain sinful thoughts, etc.
- **3)** We subdue sinful thoughts, etc., when they arise by the Spirit & with Scripture.
- **4)** We cultivate godly habits in their place humbly & prayerfully.
