Racism, Critical Race Theory, & the Gospel

3 statements up front:

- 1. Racism is a real thing, racism is horrible, racism is a sin, racism hurts people
 - a. Against Blacks, against Mexicans, against Asians, & against whites
- 2. CRT is an utterly ineffective humanist philosophy based in God hating atheism
- 3. Jesus has already solved the problem of racism.

#1 - Roots of Critical Race Theory

Classic Marxism

- God: Human society was understood as under God's authority and revelation
- Enlightenment: With the enlightenment period in 1600's & 1700's...
- *Modernism*: in the 1700's & 1800's we see the development of Modernism, where science becomes the authority over society

• **Post-modernism**: develops in the mid 1900's the concept as the Modernist authority of Science is thrown out for

Frankfurt School mutation

Big names in the Frankfurt school are: *Antonio Gramsci*, Herbert Marcuse, Max Horkheimer, Michael Foucault

Frankfurt mutation to cultural Marxism is this:

- Classic Marxism = evil oppressors vs innocent oppressed
 - The oppressors build systems in society to keep control & to keep the oppressed people oppressed (*Hegemony*)
 - This is all about money, wealth, property
 - The social systems must be destroyed through revolution to remove the oppressors
- Cultural Marxism (Neo-Marxism) = no longer about money & property systems
 - o The evil oppression happens on cultural identity: race, sex, gender
 - Oppressor is: white, male, heterosexual, & Christian
 - Using: White supremacy, patriarchy, and Christian morality
 - o Added to oppressors: healthy, able bodied, *Cisgender* (identifying with birth gender)
 - The innocent oppressed are: non-white, female, homosexual, no-binary, transgender, cripples, and overweight people (all different types of *Critical Theories*)

American Legal mutation

Lawyers developed the concept of *Critical Race Theory*

Two big names: Derrick Bell & Kimberle Crenshaw – both black lawyers

#3 - Critical Race Theory & the Church

The biggest problems are:

- 1. The Bible is no longer sufficient or authoritative
- 2. Sin is no longer in the heart of man, but in the system
- 3. Some are righteous, because they are in the oppressed groups
- 4. Some are guilty without actually sinning
- 5. Original sin is now whiteness & masculinity
- 6. There is not repentance & redemption, only eternal penance
- 7. Social Justice has, for many, become the gospel, meaning destroying the oppressors & freeing the oppressed has become the gospel
- 8. Government has become God
- 9. Heaven is found here through liberated oppressed

This is all a totally different faith & religion all together & it is not Biblical Christianity

John MacAurthur calls this "the greatest threat to the gospel in his lifetime"

Voddie Baucham, from Fault Lines, p224

Nothing will repair the fault lines. Nothing will. These divisions are both real and necessary. As I said at the outset, the goal here is to be on the right side of the fault line when the catastrophe comes.

We are facing 2 competing worldviews that are incompatible with each other:

• On 1 side: Biblical Truth, God as THE AUTHORITY

• On other side: Cultural Marxist Social Justice, man's identity is the authority

#4 - The Bible & Racism

Gen. 6:5 The LORD saw that the wickedness of man was great in the earth, and that every intention of the thoughts of his heart was only evil continually.

For there is no distinction: 23 for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God, 24 and are justified by his grace as a gift, through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus,

Col. 3:10 and have put on the new self, which is being <u>renewed in knowledge after the image</u> of its creator. **11** Here there is not <u>Greek and Jew</u>, <u>circumcised</u> and <u>uncircumcised</u>, <u>barbarian</u>, <u>Scythian</u>, slave, free; but Christ is all, and in all.

Gal. 3:27 For as many of you as were baptized into Christ have put on Christ. **28** There is neither <u>Jew</u> nor <u>Greek</u>, there is neither <u>slave</u> nor <u>free</u>, there is no <u>male</u> and <u>female</u>, for <u>you are all one in Christ</u> Jesus.

Eph. 2:14 For <u>he himself is our peace</u>, who has <u>made us both one</u> and has <u>broken down</u> in his flesh <u>the dividing wall of hosti</u>lity **15** by abolishing the law of commandments expressed in ordinances, that he might <u>create in himself one new man in place of the two, so making peace</u>, **16** and <u>might reconcile</u> <u>us both to God in one body through the cross, thereby killing the hostility</u>.

The Sin of Partiality

James 2:1 My brothers, show no partiality as you hold the faith in our Lord Jesus Christ, the Lord of glory. 2 For if a man wearing a gold ring and fine clothing comes into your assembly, and a poor man in shabby clothing also comes in, 3 and if you pay attention to the one who wears the fine clothing and say, "You sit here in a good place," while you say to the poor man, "You stand over there," or, "Sit down at my feet," 4 have you not then made distinctions among yourselves and become judges with evil thoughts? 5 Listen, my beloved brothers, has not God chosen those who are poor in the world to be rich in faith and heirs of the kingdom, which he has promised to those who love him? 6 But you have dishonored the poor man. Are not the rich the ones who oppress you, and the ones who drag you into court? 7 Are they not the ones who blaspheme the honorable name by which you were called? 8 If you really fulfill the royal law according to the Scripture, "You shall love your neighbor as yourself," you are doing well. 9 But if you show partiality, you are committing sin and are convicted by the law as transgressors.
