Exposition of Hosea The Case Against Faithless Israel (1) Hos. 4:1-14

Introduction (second main section)

- 1. This is a lawsuit (rib) oracle. A courtroom speech.
- 2. It extends from 4:1-11:11
- 3. 4:1 lays out the three indictments
 - (1) No emet
 - (2) No hesed

(3) No knowledge of God
The indictments are then addressed in reversed order
No knowledge of God (4:2-6:3)
No lovingkindness (6:4-10:15)
No truth (11:12-14:9)

I. The Summons

- A. Hear/listen to the Word of the LORD, O sons of Israel
- B. Yahweh has a case against the inhabitants of the land

II. The Indictments

- A. No faithfulness
- B. No kindness
- C. No knowledge of God

III. The Specific Violations (2)

- A. Swearing cursing (3rd commandment, Ex. 20:7; Dt. 5:11)
- B. Deception (9th commandment, Ex. 20:16; Dt 5:20)
- C. Murder (6th commandment, Ex. 20:13; Dt 5:17)
- D. Stealing (8th commandment, Ex 20:15; Dt 5:19)
- E. Adultery (7th commandment, Ex. 20:14; Dt 5:18)

F. Employ violence (ESV, they break all bounds) to tear, to break, signifies in this instance a violent breaking in upon others, for the purpose of robbery and murder¹ -- So that bloodshed follows bloodshed

IV. The Sentence (3)

- A. A picture of drought Lev. 26:19; Dt. 28:22-24
- B. Life and land suffer because of the sins of the nation
