I. Seeking God

Learning True Obedience

- A. True obedience includes seeking, thirsting, and desiring God. What do we want in life?
- B. Sinful seeking is thirsting for that which cannot satisfy or quench our spiritual thirst.
- C. The positive instruction is that as those with whom God has established His covenant, we must seek God and teach our children to seek God. What is seeking God?

II. Delighting in Righteousness

A. God's law requires that at all times we hate all sin with our whole heart and *delight* in all righteousness.
