



“Glorifying God”

Antidote to Murmuring
Exodus 16:10-21

We glorify Him when we :

I. Look-“the glory of God appeared” (vs. 10-15)

He excels past:

- A. **Negativity** – “I have heard the murmuring”
- B. **Nature** – “behold, upon the face of the wilderness”
- C. **Normal** – “for they wist not what it was”

II. Lean -“this is the thing...the LORD commanded” (vs. 16-18)

He excites us for:

- A. **Gathering** – “Gather of it every man”
- B. **Giving** – “take ye every man for them...in his tents”
- C. **Gratitude** – “some more, some less”

III. Listen - “Let no man leave of it until the morning” (vs. 19-21)

He exposes our:

- A. **Stubbornness** – “they hearkened not unto Moses”
- B. **Stinginess** - “it bred worms, and stank”
- C. **Slothfulness** - “when the sun waxed hot, it melted”

Sentence Sermon:

“God is glorified when others see our high opinion of Him in the way we live our lives.”
