

- Paul asserts that, because of our union with Christ, we are already in the highest form of spirituality that there is
- We have received all things that pertain to life and godliness
- $\bullet \mbox{It}$ is now for us to live out what we are in cooperation with the Holy Spirit

THE PRESENT CALL TO PUT TO OFF (5-9A)	7
Put to death therefore what is earthly in you: sexual immorality, impurity, passion, evil desire,	
and covetousness, which is idolatry.	
On account of these the wrath of God is coming.	
In these you too <i>once</i> walked, when you were living in them.	-
But now you must put them all away:	
anger, wrath, malice, slander, and obscene talk from your mouth.	-
Do not lie to one another.

THE PAST REALITY OF A NEW PERSON (9B-11)	٦
seeing that you have put off the <i>old self</i> with its practices	
and have put on the <i>new self</i> ,	
which is being renewed in knowledge after the image of its creator.	
Here there is not Greek and Jew,	
circumcised and uncircumcised,	
barbarian, Scythian, slave, free;	-
but Christ is all, and in all.

THE PRECENT ALL TO PHE ON (42 44)	٦
THE PRESENT ALL TO PUT ON (12-14) Put on then, as God's chosen ones, holy and beloved,	
compassionate hearts, kindness,	
humility, meekness, and patience,	
bearing with one another and, if one has a complaint against another,	
forgiving each other;	
as the Lord has forgiven you,	
so you also must forgive. And above all these put on love,	
which binds everything together in perfect harmony.
