THE HUNTERS SOUTH AFRICA

Excerpts from a recent update

Hello everyone!

It's a privilege to share all that God is doing in our lives and our ministry here in South Africa. We are grateful to be given the opportunity to serve the King in this wonderful place.

I say it's wonderful and it is. The biggest challenge in our lives these days is power outages. We endure daily power outages for hours at a time, and it interferes with everything from Bible studies to meal preparation. We have a quotation on a UPS (Uninterrupted Power Supply), which runs on lithium-ion batteries and is recharged when the power is on. The wait time is significant, however, since almost everyone in this country is installing them at the moment!

Megan's eyesight is near perfect since her surgery. She isn't even wearing glasses anymore! Megan is doing so well, in fact, that she is flying to Alberta, Canada to spend the rest of the summer with her brother, who has landed her a job at Home Hardware. She's looking forward to reconnecting with her older brother and her sister-in-law, who she hasn't seen in almost 2 years. She'll be back to Faith in the fall, and I think she's excited to get back. Thanks to all who have prayed. It's been a nerve-wracking process at times, but God is always faithful! We'll be sad to see Megan go this coming Sunday. I wouldn't normally say anything, but since several have asked, Megan's flights have had an additional cost. We're out of pocket about \$3000 for the flights here and back to Edmonton. We're grateful to those who think of these additional expenses and who offer to help! We're always grateful to see God meet our needs.

We took the boys from our weekly boys' Bible study this weekend to the gym where I work out. They enjoyed a couple of hours of weightlifting and fun competitions to see who was the strongest, etc. I challenged the boys with Paul's words to Timothy when he says that although bodily exercise has some profit, godliness has profit in this life and in the life to come! We had 16 young men at the activity. Continue to pray for these boys!

Our intern from Faith has been a nice addition to our home these past few weeks. He has about a week and a half left before he leaves to return to the USA, but not before the gets to preach this weekend. We have assigned him a challenging text, but we are certain he will do well. He has put many hours of study in!

We were back in Rheenendal after missing three weeks due to sickness. There were some good questions tonight and I was able to help use God's word to correct some of the "name it and claim it" theology that is so prevalent in the colored community.

Sunday continues to draw a good crowd. We are going to take an all-church trip out to the property we are looking at. We've invited many of the church folks to join us to look at the property. I need to know if they see the potential that we do. If the property was half the price, I wouldn't bat an eye, but if the price could be met, it would so obviously be of the Lord that I am sure it would be a faith-building moment. We're cautiously looking at this property and trying to be careful and wise at the same time.

Much counseling continues...and there are numerous challenges. Please pray fervently that we would see God work in such a way that lives, marriages and homes would be transformed.

We have a married couple retreat coming up for our church folks, so we're excited about how God will use that – and Nelson, Michelle's husband is planning to come. That's big news, since this would be the first and only thing he has attended with us!

Thanks for praying friends - we so appreciate you all!
