

## Obedience: The Ultimate Test of True Faith 2 Corinthians 13:5-14

Tests of genuine, obedient faith:

- 1. First, care to examine your faith: is Christ in you? (13:5)
- Must conclude that Christ's apostles speak His words (13:3, 6)
- 3. "Do no wrong" by repenting of sins (7a)
- More concerned about others repentance than vindicating oneself (7b)
- Loath to work against the truth; love for it (8)
- 6. Rejoicing in weakness (9; cf. 12:9-10)
- Desiring completeness in God's people (9b)
- Working to edify Christ's church, not misrepresenting it, causing others to stumble (10)
- 9. Always rejoicing in God's grace (11a)
- 10. Always working to complete oneself by living for God's glory (11b)
- Being comforted always knowing God is in control (11c)
- 12. Agreeing with believers about Christ (11d)
- 7 Living in peace w/ our brothers in Christ (11e)
- 14. Greeting God's people with love & affection (12)
- 15 Sending love to Christians all over the world (13)
- 16. Desiring results: that Christ's grace, God's love & peace, and the Spirit's fel lowship will never depart from us (11, 14)
