

**“The Glorious Revelation of Jesus Christ”**  
**John 21:24-25**

---

The glorious revelation of Jesus Christ contained in the Scriptures  
is inexhaustible in its riches!

**1. A Spirit-breathed Revelation!**

v. 24

**(1) Apostolic Testimony**

*“This is the disciple who testifies of these things,  
and wrote these things;  
and we know that his testimony is true.”*

**-1- The Apostle John**

- “The disciple whom Jesus loved” 13:23; 19:26; 20:2; 21:7, 20
- This is his *written* testimony

**-2- Significance**

- The Apostolic testimony is the very testimony of the living God
- Thus, e.g., 1 Jn. 4:6

**(2) Self-Authenticating Testimony!**

**-1- The living God needs no “corroborating testimony!”**

**-2- His Word is truth. It is the out-breathing of the Spirit.** 2 Tim. 3:16

**(3) The Church’s Recognition of this Testimony**

*“we know that his testimony is true.”*

**-1- A Spirit-borne Testimony!**

- Not merely that he has been truthful in what he has written,  
but that what he has written is the very truth of God!
  
- The Church – all true believers – convinced by the infallible witness of the Spirit;
  
- cf. WCF I:V

**-2- An Indelible Testimony!**

- Forever written upon the heart! cf. 1 John 2:20-21

**2. An Inexhaustible Revelation!**

v. 25

**(1) The Apostle was selective** cf. 20:30-31

*“And there are also many other things  
that Jesus did...”*

**-1- Jesus did many other signs not recorded in this gospel**

**-2- These were written that you may believe**

**(2) The Works of Jesus Christ are Inexhaustible in their meaning!**

**Why?**

*“things...which, if they were written one by one,  
I suppose that even the world itself could not contain  
the books that would be written. Amen.”*

**-1- Because they are THE WORKS OF GOD!**

**-2- Because God is infinite!**
