"GETTING BACK TOGETHER" NEHEMIAH 8

- I. A GREAT TIMEOUT
 - A. The promises of God, the Covenant Keeper
 - 1. <u>Blessings</u> for obedience to the covenant fruitfulness in the blessed land
 - 2. <u>Judgments</u> for disobedience removal from the land; to rethink the commitment to God; punitive for some; instructional for some; a resented annoyance for many
 - 3. <u>Restoration</u> for repentance return to the land and the blessings of His presence
 - B. The promises of the Exile and return Jer 25; 29
 - C. The return in part not everyone came home
 - 1. They had new homes; a new life
 - 2. Home is where the heart is
 - 3. Not well enough; too old; too young; lacking
 - 4. Home was not a good place to be: trouble, ruin, rubble; too much work
 - D. Fresh motivation from God, fresh action, home repair, creating stability, restoring order

II. A GREAT GET TOGETHER

- A. The call of God for an assembly
- B. Coming together as "one man": the importance of proper unity around the center of faith in God, His Christ, His Word
- C. The leadership was <u>committed</u> to the Word of God and an active faith in God; to restoration

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- D. Presentation of the Word of God the central uniting element Blessing God
 - 1. God's covenant with His wife marriage vows
 - 2. "profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness"
 - 3. "For the word of God is living and powerful,...
 ...piercing even to the division of soul and
 spirit,... a discerner of the thoughts and intents
 of the heart."
 - 4. Reading and giving the meaning and sense
 - a. Faith of the reader; faith of the hearer
 - b. Cooperation of the Spirit of God and the rational thinking of the people
 - c. Understanding of the teacher; the willing learning of the hearer
 - d. Explaining it in the correct language
 - 5. Listening
 - a. Their ears were "to the Book of the Law"
 - b. To understand not to argue, to reply, to deny, to judge; conviction of wrongdoing had brought them broken humility
 - 6. Responding
 - a. Agreement "Amen"
 - b. Complete submission to it and its author
 - c. Worship indication of worth and humility before Him shown in body, soul and spirit
 - d. Weeping
 - E. Comfort celebrate, share; the joy of the LORD is our strength; it's a holy day
