Introduction

1. Psalm 8 celebrates the incomprehensible majesty and glory of Jehovah God
2. Not only does David praise the excellent name of the Lord, but the glory and praise of God is declared from the lips of our children

The Idea

1. The word "strength" can be better translated, "praise." What is praise?
2. God has ordained that this praise comes from the mouths of babes and sucklings.
3. This teaches us what the focus of our speech and homes must be: praising God's excellent name!

The Reason...because of thine enemies

1. The idea here is that God uses praise coming from the mouths of children to silence God's enemies.
2. Why does God do this?
3. How does God work through the praise of children to overcome the enemy?

The Possibility

1. First, it comes by the ordination of God. God has declared this.
2. Second, God uses the means of the instruction of parents.
