Introduction

- 1. As the Heidelberg Catechism (HC) develops the doctrine of sin, it helps us to think Biblically about sin.
- 2. We must see ourselves tonight as sinners before a just God.

The Horrible Guilt...Am I guilty before the just God?

- 1. As we stand before the holy, just God, His verdict is, "Guilty! You must be punished for your sins!" The question of the HC is, "Is this just? Is this right?"
- 2. God's verdict upon us as we stand before His majesty in His court of holiness is rightly, "Guilty!"

The Just Punishment (HC Question 10)

- 1. Those who are guilty deserve punishment.
- 2. The punishment we deserve is temporal.
- 3. This temporal judgment of God upon the wicked becomes the eternal torments of hell.

- 1. How does God's mercy fit with His justice?
- 2. This is my identity sinner saved by grace.
