Introduction: Applying what we learn

- 1. Holy Brethren!
 - a. How we view one another
 - b. How we view ourselves before God
 - c. How we live our lives (heavenly calling)...
- 2. Consider Christ!
 - a. Our Help
 - i. Apostle of our confession: ministered on heaven's behalf to us. Faithfully completed His work.
 - ii. High Priest of our confession: ministering on our behalf in heaven. Faithfully completing His work.
 - b. Our Hope
 - i. Not in any other apostle, high priest, or any other person... least of all myself
 - ii. In God who became a man
 - 1. Christ is the builder (v3). So He is God (v4).
 - 2. But He is not just the builder of a building; He is the "Son" to Moses' "servant."
 - 3. This was Moses' greatest "testimony of those things which would be spoken afterward" (cf. Deut 18:15-19)

Conclusion: not just a building but a family. Not just a Builder but a brother. Note, however, the family mark: the exulting in the hope. What is "the hope"? That because Christ's faithful fulling of His mission, we will soon be outfitted with His glory, as we behold and delight in Him forever. Let us consider Him now, Whom we will consider forever.
