What Is?

- A heart at peace gives life to the body, but envy rots the bones, Proverbs 14:30
- Love is patient, love is kind. It does not envy, it does not boast, it is not proud, 1 Corinthians 13:4
- For where you have envy and selfish ambition, there you find disorder and every evil practice, James 3:16
- Envy is perverted because it "loves" what other people possess, rather than what is good, beautiful and True.
- Envy eats away at the heart of the envious person.
- Envy takes away gratitude. Envious people close themselves off to the grace of God.



Numbers 12:1

1 And Miriam and Aaron spake against Moses because of the Ethiopian woman whom he had married: for he had married an Ethiopian

**The criticism and questioning of
God's servant (v.1-3).**

1 Miriam and Aaron began to talk against Moses because of his Cushite wife, for he had married a Cushite. (NIV)

Numbers 12:2

2 And they said, Hath the LORD indeed spoken only by Moses? hath he not spoken also by us? And the LORD heard *it*. (KJV)

2 They said, "Has the LORD spoken only through Moses? Hasn't he also spoken through us?" The LORD heard what they said. (TEV)

2 "Has the LORD spoken only through Moses?" they asked. "Hasn't he also spoken through us?" And the LORD heard this. (NIV)

3 (Moses was a humble man, more humble than anyone else on earth.) (TEV)

Numbers 12:4

4 And the LORD spake suddenly unto Moses, and unto Aaron, and unto Miriam, Come out ye three unto the tabernacle of the congregation. And they three came

The chastisement and judgment of God (v.4-12).

4 At once the LORD said to Moses, Aaron and Miriam, "Come out to the Tent of Meeting, all three of you." So the three of them came out. (NIV)

Numbers 12:5

5 And the LORD came down in the pillar of the cloud, and stood *in* the door of the tabernacle, and called Aaron and Miriam: and they both came forth. (KJV)

5 and the LORD came down in a pillar of cloud, stood at the entrance of the Tent, and called out, "Aaron! Miriam!" The two of them stepped forward, (TEV)

5 Then the LORD came down in a pillar of cloud; he stood at the entrance to the Tent and summoned Aaron and Miriam. When both of them stepped forward, (NIV)

Numbers 12:10

10 And the cloud departed from off the tabernacle; and, behold, Miriam *became* leprous, *white* as snow: and Aaron looked upon Miriam, and, behold, *she was* leprous. (KJV)

10 and the cloud left the Tent, Miriam's skin was suddenly covered with a dreaded disease and turned as white as snow. When Aaron looked at her and saw that she was covered with the disease, (TEV)

10 When the cloud lifted from above the Tent, there stood Miriam--leprous, like snow. Aaron turned toward her and saw that she had leprosy; (NIV)

11 and he said to Moses, "Please, my lord, do not hold against us the sin we have so foolishly committed. (NIV)

Numbers 12:14

14 And the LORD said unto Moses, If her father had but spit in her face, should she not be ashamed seven days? let her be shut out from the camp seven days, and after that let her be received in *again*. (KJV)

14 The LORD answered, "If her father had spit in her face, she would have to bear her disgrace for seven days. So let her be shut out of the camp for a week, and after that she can be brought back in." (TEV)

14 The LORD replied to Moses, "If her father had spit in her face, would she not have been in disgrace for seven days? Confine her outside the camp for seven days; after that she can be brought back." (NIV)
