How do families get so fragmented?

- 1. Unmet **expectations** can put pressure on a home (v.19-22).
 - a. Unexpected **delay** (v.21).
 - b. Unanswered **prayer** (v.21).
 - c. Unexplained **problem pregnancy** (v.22).
- 2. Sibling **rivalries** (v.23-26).
 - a. Rivalries can **start early**. V.22
 - b. Rivalries are intensified by **exploitation** (25:29-34)
 - i. Never sacrifice your **future** on the altar of the **immediate**.
 - c. Rivalries are perpetuated by **deception** (27:1-40).
- 3. When parents **show favoritism** (25:27-28).
 - a. Sometimes parents show favoritism because of some **physical appearance**
 - b. Sometimes parents show favoritism because of **talents and abilities**.
 - c. Sometimes the favoritism gets **out of hand** (27.41)
 - d. This favoritism and sibling rivalry can <u>last a life time</u>. How did this all begin?

So:

- Don't play **favorites**!
- Don't feed rivalries!
- Don't **scheme** against each other and
- Don't give into to your **appetites**!
- <u>Do</u> seek <u>reconciliation</u>
