

Gathering of the People of God

For there is one God and one Mediator between God and men: the man Christ Jesus. 1 Tim. 2:5 led by Pastor Jeff Gregory

Invitation to the Table

Leader: Jesus said, "I will ask the Father, and he will give you another Counselor to be with you forever — the Spirit of Truth." Friends in Christ, today we celebrate the fulfillment of this promise. We know that Christ is with us through his Spirit and now we realize his presence at this holy meal. All who love and serve the Lord Jesus and trust him alone to save them from their sins are welcome to this Table. As we approach his Table, let us bring our praise to God.

In Praise of God, the Father, our Creator

Leader: Blessed are you, God Most High, Creator of heaven and earth. You fashioned us in your image that we might live in joyous fellowship with you. Even after we broke the bonds of that fellowship, you loved us and sought us. Therefore, we offer our praise to you with joy:

People: Holy, holy, holy Lord, God of power and might, heaven and earth are full of you glory. Hosanna in the highest!

In Praise of God the Son, our Redeemer

Leader: Blessed are you, Jesus Christ, Son of God, and our Lord. You came to be our Immanuel, God with us. When we were dead in our trespasses and sin you brought us into fellowship with God by your victory over sin and death. You promised that you would not leave us, and indeed you sent the Spirit to be our Comforter and Sustainer. You gave us this joyful feast, by which we realize afresh our union with you and proclaim your death and resurrection. Therefore, we offer our praise to you and say with joy:

People: Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord. Hosanna in the highest!

Leader: People of God, remember that the Lord Jesus, on the night when he was betrayed, took bread, and when he had given thanks, he broke it and said, "This is my body, which is for you: do this in remembrance of me. " In the same way, he took the cup after supper, saying, "This cup is the new covenant in my blood; do this, whenever you drink it, in remembrance of me. For whenever you eat this bread and drink this cup, you proclaim the Lord's death until he comes. " (1 Cor. 11 23-16).

People: We shall do as our Lord commands. Through the power of the Spirit we celebrate this feast, proclaiming that our Lord died, is risen, and is coming again.

In Praises of God, the Spirit, Our Comforter

Leader: Bless are you, Holy Spirit, our Comforter. At creation you hovered over the waters and brought order out of chaos. You led Abraham and Sarah to the chosen land and through them called a people to be your very own. You overshadowed Mary, and she conceived a Son who would save his people from their sins. When John baptized Christ you descended from heaven to anoint him for his ministry as Messiah. At Pentecost you came like the rush of a mighty wind, filling the apostles with power from on high, making of their many tongues the one new tongue of witness to you. You have been present with the church through many ages and in many lands, inspiring her witness to the crucified and risen Lord Jesus Christ. Therefore, we offer our praise to you: *Glory to the Father, glory to the Son, and glory to the Holy Spirit, one God, now and forever.*

Pastor: As people who were once lost in the darkness and ignorance of sin, we thank you gracious Father, that you sent your Son to die and rise for our salvation, and poured forth your Spirit from heaven through Christ into our hearts so that we might know your love and receive eternal life. Triune God, Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, we praise and thank you for bringing us to yourself that we might be your people, and you would be our God.

People: We give you thanks, God of power and might, that you send your Spirit to us now, breathing life into your people and strengthening us with these gifts, that we may receive afresh Christ's own life.

Prayer of Consecration: (Dedicating ourselves and these elements to holy use) - a man in the congregation.

Breaking of the Bread

Leader: The gifts of God for the people of God!

The body of Christ, the bread of heaven, given to you by the power of the Spirit.

People: Thanks be to God!

Communion Hymn #652 – In Memory of the Savior's Love

We promise to walk in your ways, confident of your promise that your Spirit will never depart from us. We offer ourselves to you, Lord God, in the name of our Savior Jesus Christ.

People: *Amen.*

The Thanksgiving

Leader: Bless the Lord, O my soul; and all that is within me, bless his holy name!

People: Bless the Lord, O my soul, and forget none of his benefits.

He forgives all our sins and crowns us with his love and compassion. Hallelujah! (Psalm 103: 1-2)
