In love ⁵ he predestined us for **adoption to himself** as sons through Jesus Christ, according to the purpose of his will, 6 to the praise of his glorious grace, with which he has blessed us in the Beloved. ⁷ In him we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of our trespasses, according to the riches of his grace, ⁸ which he lavished upon us, in all wisdom and insight ⁹ making known to us the mystery of his will, according to his purpose, which he set forth in Christ ¹⁰ as a plan for the fullness of time, to **unite all things in him**, things in heaven and things on earth.¹¹ In him we have obtained an inheritance, having been predestined

according to the purpose of him who works all things according to the counsel of his will, ¹² so that we who were the first to hope in Christ might be to the praise of his glory. ¹³ In him you also, when you heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation, and believed in him, were sealed with the promised Holy Spirit, ¹⁴ who is the guarantee of our inheritance until we acquire possession of it, to the praise of his glory.



Union comes before Communion

What can separate us from the love of God in Christ Jesus (Romans 8).

In Christ- we are in an eternal covenant relationship.

Our communion with God - the ability to feel His love, can fluctuate.

Our union with Christ - total one-sided act of divine grace that secures us in covenant with Him, and applies all of Christ's redemptive work to us.

The Body of Christ, we need to encourage one another in truth.

Christ unites us with each other because we are IN HIM. 1 John 1:1-3. Fellowship is a consequence of our union with Christ.

We are united to His life, His joy, His peace, His love. Not just that we have life and joy and peace and love because we are in Him, but that we have His life, and joy, and peace, and love because He is in us.
