## Who is First?

Luke 9:51-62 Pastor Phil Winfield June 15, 2014

To Jerusalem! To the Ascension! (9:51, 53, 56; 13:22; 17:11; 18:31; 19:28)

- 1. Disciples do not resort to **retaliation** when rejected (9:51-56).
  - a. Rejection is inevitable (v.52-53).
  - b. Reactions to rejection are to be **merciful** (9:54-56)
    - i. Remember this is the **day of Grace** not judgment.
    - ii. Remember first rejections may not be **final**. (Acts 8:1, 4–25; 9:31; 15:3).
    - iii. Remember extreme reactions are always **inappropriate**.
- 2. Disciples follow Jesus without reservations (9:57-58).
  - a. Followers can never be **flippant** or frivolous.
  - b. Followers can never be **half-hearted** in their commitment.
- 3. Disciples follow Jesus without **negotiations** (9:59-60).
  - a. There are no negotiations as to who is first.
  - b. There are no negotiations because **financial** considerations.
  - c. Let the **dead** bury their dead? Huh?
- 4. Disciples follow Jesus without **hesitations** (9:61-62).
  - a. Disciples cannot **hesitate**.
  - b. Disciples cannot **vacillate**

You can't say, Lord, and **me first** in the same sentence.
