Why do I preach the way I do?

2 Timothy 3:14 – 4:5

The main point

In the time between Jesus's first coming and second coming, Paul commands every pastor to be a man of the Bible a man who continually trusts the Bible himself (3:14-17) and a man who continually heralds the Bible to others (4:1-5).

- God-breathed (v. 16)
- Clear (v. 15)
- Sufficient (v. 17)

My preaching should be marked by...

- a sober sense of accountability (v. 1)
- personal application and patient instruction (v. 2)
- refusal to entertain (vv. 3-4)
- constant evangelism (v. 5)
