

#### THE TWO BLESSINGS (IS IT EASY TO BELIEVE?)

Genesis 15:5 And he brought him forth abroad, and said, Look now toward heaven, and tell the stars, if thou be able to number them: and he said unto him, So shall thy seed be. 6 And he believed in the Lord; and he counted it to him for righteousness. 7 And he said unto him, I am the LORD that brought thee out of Ur of the Chaldees, to give thee this land to inherit it.

**Romans 4:3 For what saith** the scripture? Abraham believed God, and it was counted unto him for righteousness.

**Romans 4:4 Now to him that** worketh not, but believeth on him that justifieth the ungodly, his faith is counted for righteousness.

**Romans 4:13 For the promise,** that he should be the heir of the world, was not to Abraham, or to his seed, through the law, but through the righteousness of faith.

Acts 26:18 To open their eyes, and to turn them from darkness to light, and from the power of Satan unto God, that they may receive forgiveness of sins, and inheritance among them which are sanctified by faith that is in me.

17 That in blessing I will bless thee, and in multiplying I will multiply thy seed as the stars of the heaven...
