IT MATTERS HOW YOU WORSHIP

I. Take care not to worship Yahweh wrongly (vv. 2-4, 29-31).

- A. Be careful not to worship God in the wrong place.
- B. Be careful not to worship God by the wrong means.

II. Take care to worship Yahweh rightly (vv. 5-28).

- A. Be careful to worship God in the right place.
- B. Be careful to worship God by the right means.

QUESTIONS FOR FAMILY WORSHIP

- 1. How does Moses structure his preaching of the stipulations of the covenant in chapters 6-26?
- 2. What commandment does Moses open up in Deuteronomy 12?
- 3. According to Deuteronomy 12:32, what alone is to govern and direct our worship of God?
- 4. How would Israel be tempted in the land of Canaan to worship God wrongly? How are we tempted today?
- 5. What was God's chosen place of worship under the old covenant? What is His chosen place under the new covenant? How does that inform our understanding of things like livestream?
- 6. What are the means God has called us to use in His worship as we gather as His new covenant temple?

QUESTIONS FOR PRIVATE REFLECTION

- 1. Am I careful and watchful to make sure my worship and the worship of my church is pleasing in God's sight? Do I have a zeal for God's worship?
- 2. Do I see the significance of the place in which worship is carried out? Do I view the corporate gathering of God's people as absolutely essential or optional?
- 3. How is the American church (including our own denomination) tempted today to use other means in worship than those God has prescribed?
