"Since Christ Reconciles You to God Overcome Your Sins Through Him" 1 John 2:1-2

1 My little children, I am writing these things to you so that you may not sin. But if anyone does sin, we have an advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous. 2 He is the propitation for our sins, and not for ours only but also for the sins of the whole world.

- I. Do not misunderstand John as if he were inventing a doctrine of universal salvation. (2b)
- II. Nor should you despair as if he were demanding perfectionism.(1)
- III. But, John is tenderly speaking to you as those who are tempted to sin. (1a)
- IV. In Christ you have been reconciled to God the Father. (2a)
- V. And you can rely upon Him to be your advocate as you have need. (1b)
- VI. Only Christ can be your mediator before God; Don't let anyone tell you otherwise. (1b, 2b)
