

## Sermon Notes—PM

You Belong to an "Insignificant" Kingdom Rev. Danny Hyde, Pastor Matthew 13:31–33 Studies in Matthew #48

Matthew 13 is the third of Jesus' five discourses to his disciples (chs. 5–7; 10; 13; 18–20; 24–25). In this discourse we continue Jesus' parables about the kingdom of God, which I have previously described as that rule of God and the relationship with God that exists in heaven in the presence of God but that now comes to earth in the coming of Jesus.

The parables of the mustard seed and leaven are meant to encourage us about the kingdom, despite our being discouraged when we look at it with worldly eyes.
