v 1-2 **Exodus 19:10-18**

v 3 *terrible things* - **Deuteronomy 10:17-21, Nehemiah 1:5, Job 39:20, Psalm 66:1-5 & 76:12; Song 6:4**

Verses 4-6 contain some great Doctrinal Truths:

v 4 (1) There is 'None like God' - **Exodus 15:11, 2 Samuel 7:22, Isaiah 43:10-11**
(2) We must 'Wait on God' - **Psalm 40:1 & 130:6**

v 5 (3) *we have sinned* - v 6
(4) sin angers God : *thou art wroth*
(5) sinners can be saved - *we shall be saved*
(6) which sinners? - *those that remember thee in thy ways*
 - v 4, *him that waiteth* = **Lamentations 3:26**
(7) God has fellowship with joyful believers - *Thou meetest him that rejoiceth*
(8) God has fellowship with obedient believers - *worketh righteousness* - **Phil 2:12**

v 6 (a) Doctrinal Truth: Man has a fallen nature
 Genesis 5:3 & 9:21, 1 Kings 8:38, Psalm 51:4-5, Ecclesiastes 8:20, Isaiah 53:6, Romans 3:23
(b) Spiritual Truth: Believers carry a body with a fallen nature **Romans 8:18 & 24**
(c) This verse corrects the erroneous teaching of 'Dispensational Salvation'.
 An error that stems from a misreading of - **Deuteronomy 6:24-25**

v 7 hist: Isaiah's day was one of spiritual indifference and prayerlessness.
 spir: Ours is a day of indifference towards the word of God.
 therefore: *thou hast hid thy face ... and consumed us*

consumed : def. - burnt up, squandered, expended

v 8 *thou art our Father*

 hist: of Israel **Exodus 4:22 & Jeremiah 31:9**
 spir: of believers **Galatians 3:26 & Galatians 4:4-6**

v 9-12 ~ **Psalm 6:1-4**
