What is freedom to a worm? On a fishing hook or tunneling in a garden?

What is freedom to a child of God? Psalm 119:45 “I will walk at liberty for I seek your precepts.”

Our true freedom depends on discovering how we can give expression to our true nature. James tells his beloved brethren that "the royal law of liberty" is our calling.

Versions of Freedom on Father's Day 2022: John 8:32-36 06 17 2022

Liberty: 1. The condition of being not subject to restriction or control. 2. The right to act in a manner of one's own choosing.

Freedom: 1. The condition of being free of restraints. 2. liberty of a person from slavery, oppression, or incarceration (jail).

We are seeing and hearing strange notions of freedom regarding gender identity aren't we? A loud minority claim that they are not subject to the restriction of the very obvious biological birth genders—male or female.

Hannah Anderson made this shrewd insight regarding the connected crises of *fatherlessness* and *abortion*: “Generally speaking, men are physically stronger than women and so their natural temptation would be to use their strength to control women. We see this every time a man physically abuses a woman. We see it every time a man uses his power to harass or intimidate a woman. But we also see it every time a man walks away from a woman who is pregnant with his child. When he abandons her, he is taking advantage of the fact that an infant grows inside its mother and not its father. In a broken world where might makes right, the physical make up of a man's body gives him an advantage that a woman usually does not have.” And, “The biological differences between men and women are part of the reason abortion exists. Through the act of abortion, women mimic the same biological *freedom* that men possess naturally. After a child is conceived, a man may or may not choose to stay with the mother, but nothing physically binds him to her. And so, instead of shouldering the responsibility, many walk away. Unfortunately, instead of correcting this, abortion enables women to practice the same type of abandonment, which in turn continues and makes worse the cycle of not holding men responsible to care for the children they create. If there is no child, he's off the hook—**entirely free.**”¹
